BOIL WATER ADVISORY FOR ENGLISH TURN AND LOWER COAST ALGIERS

Residents and businesses in English Turn and the entire Lower Coast of Algiers are under a precautionary "Boil Water Advisory" as a result of a rupture in a water main located in an area of the forebay of the Algiers Lock between the Intercoastal Waterway and the Mississippi River.

The Sewerage and Water Board, in conjunction with the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH), is issuing a precautionary boil water advisory that will be in effect until further notice.

The Board is recommending that customers in this area disinfect their water by boiling it for one minute and letting it cool down prior to consumption (including drinking, cooking, brushing teeth, bathing or preparing food).

The boil water advisory will remain in effect until further notice for customers in English Turn Phase I and Phase II, the Arbor and the entire Lower Coast of Algiers. The Sewerage and Water Board will notify residents when the advisory is lifted. If you have any questions, please call 52-WATER (529-2837).

Water pressure has not been restored to the affected area. The Sewerage and Water Board is working to restore service as quickly as possible.

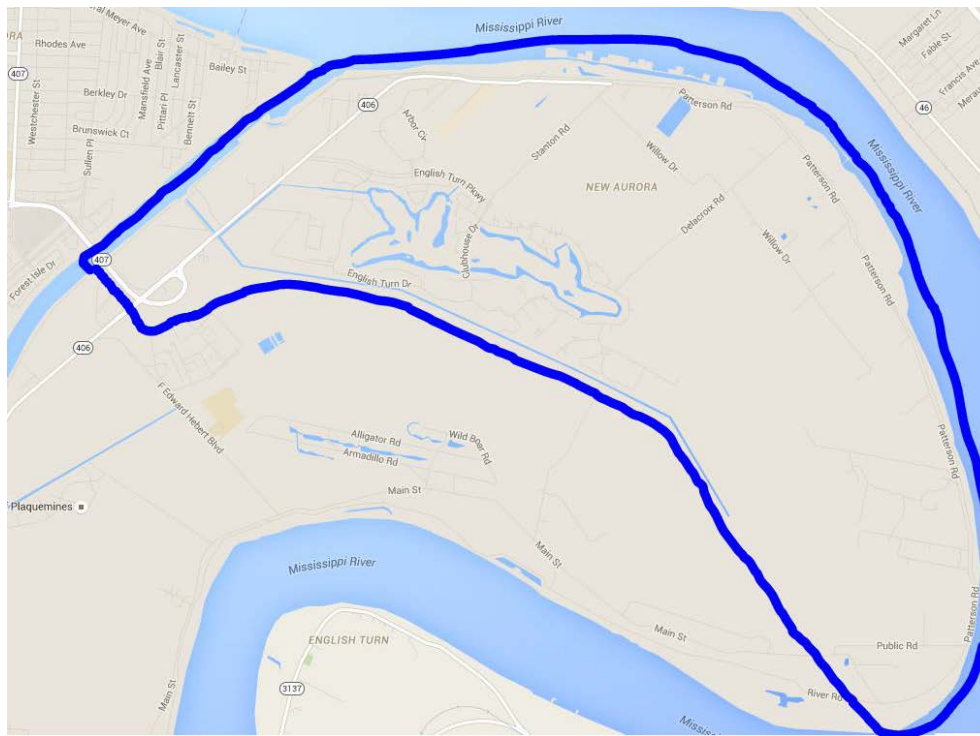
INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOILING

Boil water for one full minute in a clear container. The one minute boil time begins after the water has been brought to a rolling boil. (If there is a flat taste, it can be eliminated by shaking the water in a bottle or pouring it from one container to another).
