Bracy is New Member of The Sewerage & Water Board

Marion B. Bracy, Vice President for Facility Planning and Management at Xavier University of Louisiana since 2006, is the newest member of The Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans. He is fulfilling the unexpired term of Karen Henley-Raymond who resigned from the Board last month. His appointment runs through October 17, 2018.

Bracy, who has been at Xavier since 1998, represents Council District D on the S&WB. He was appointed to the Board by Mayor Mitchell J. Landrieu and approved by the City Council.

He is currently managing Xavier's \$200 million-plus major construction, reconstruction and renovation of buildings destroyed by Katrina and other construction related to Xavier's facility growth and development.

He began his career in the field of Property Management in 1984 at Dillard University after graduating from Dillard with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Administration that same year.
