We're improving the water system - Broadmoor Area Water main Installation Continued

The Sewerage & Water Board's contractor, Wallace C. Drennan General Contractors, began completing a planned installation of a new water main at Milan Street and S. Rocheblave Street last week. Work was temporarily paused on Friday; however, the contractor is continuing work today with cutting and capping the old line. The next phase of the job will be taking away a portion of the underground canal roof to enable the removal of the old line and installation of the new line. During the final phase of the job, the canal roof will be restored and the tie-in to the new line will occur.

There will be low water pressure when the actual tie-in is made; the contractor will distribute a low water pressure notification to affected residents. The water line repair is expected to take 10 working days. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
