We’re improving your drainage system/Traffic Advisory-SELA Jefferson Avenue

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised of a traffic lane shift for Magazine Street at Jefferson Avenue.

Weather permitting, beginning Monday, February 15, 2016 and lasting for approximately 4 weeks, the travel lanes on Magazine Street at Jefferson Avenue will shift to allow for permanent roadway restoration.

Traffic on Magazine Street will be shifted to the south side (river side) of the intersection while work is performed on the north side (lake side). Afterwards, traffic will be shifted to the north side of the intersection while work is performed on the south side.

Portions of existing Magazine Street parking lanes will be used for travel lanes during the shift. A phase traffic signal will be in place at this intersection allowing eastbound and westbound traffic to flow intermittently.

This work is related to the SELA Jefferson Avenue Drainage Canal Project.

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City’s infrastructure.
