Loud Noise at Carrollton Plant Advisory

Residents and businesses near the Sewerage and Water Board's Carrollton Plant may experience louder than normal noise levels over the next month. The Sewerage and Water Board will be testing a newly installed turbine engine generator at the Carrollton Plant.

This \$34 million project is commissioned by the Army Corps of Engineers and will provide the Sewerage and Water Board with 15-mega watt back up power generation.

The first test of this very large engine may or may not be any louder than the normal noise level at the plant. The engine itself is enclosed in a sound attenuated enclosure and building designed specifically to reduce noise levels but the sounds may be different from what residents are accustomed to hearing.

Since this new equipment has never been operated before, the Board is informing residents in the community to be aware of this testing.

The testing is scheduled to begin at or after 9 a.m. Wednesday and over the next 30 days.
