Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory

Residents and business in three sections of the Marigny area will experience low water pressure on Sunday, April 27, 2014 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. while Sewerage and Water Board crews repair a series of valves on two 24-inch water mains that serve the area.
