Residents and businesses on Canal Street from Bourbon Street to Dauphine Street and on Bourbon Street from Canal Street to Conti Street will experience low water pressure over night on Tuesday, June 30, 2015. The work will begin Tuesday at 10 p.m. until Wednesday, July, 1, 2015 at 6 a.m.

Boh Bros Construction Company will be performing tie-ins on two water lines that serve the area. This is a part of the \$188 million Sewerage and Water Board/ FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
