Low Water Pressure Advisory (Carondelet Street and Common Street)

Residents and businesses on several streets in the CBD will experience low water pressure over night on Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015 beginning at 10p.m. until 6 a.m. Friday morning, June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will be performing a tie-in on a new water line that serves the area.

The areas affected are:

ON Carondelet Street Common Street From Gravier Street St. Charles Avenue TO Canal Street Carondelet Street

This work is part of the \$188 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
