Residents and businesses on several streets of the CBD will experience low water pressure over night on Monday, June 22, 2015 beginning at midnight until 6 a.m. Tuesday morning, June 23rd.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will be performing tie-ins on two water lines that serve the area.

The areas affected are:

ON Carondelet Street Common Street Canal Street Bourbon Street From Gravier Street St. Charles Avenue Bourbon Street Canal Street

TO Canal Street Carondelet Street Dauphine Street Conti Street

This work is part of the \$188 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
