Residents and businesses on Gravier Street between S. Claiborne Avenue and LaSalle Street will experience low water pressure overnight beginning at 11 p.m. on Monday, October 26th through Tuesday, October 27th at 7:30 a.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will tie-in a new water service for the LSU Health Sciences Center.

This work is part of the \$188 million Sewerage and Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
