Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory
for the 100 block of LaSalle Street

Residents and businesses on the 100 block of LaSalle Street between Canal Street and Cleveland Avenue will experience low water pressure over night on Thursday, January 8th and again on Monday, January 12th from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. while Boh Bros. Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board performs a tie-in of a new water line that serves the area.

Also, LaSalle Street from Canal Street to Cleveland Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic while the work is in progress.

This project is part of the Sewerage and Water Board-FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
