Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory – (Downtown Area)

Resident, businesses and motorists in a part of the Downtown Area will experience low water pressure on Monday, December 28, 2015 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Motorists are also advised that the right lane of N. Claiborne Avenue (eastbound) will be closed from Dumaine Street to Ursuline Avenue while work is in progress.

Sewerage and Water Board crews will be working on a 24" valve on a water line.
