Low Water Pressure on Peniston Street and St. Charles Avenue

Residents and businesses on Peniston Street and St. Charles Avenue will experience low water pressure on Friday, August 14, 2015 from 8 a.m. until 3 p.m. while Boh Brothers Construction Company caps an existing water main. The work was originally scheduled for Thursday but has been changed to Friday.

This work is part of the \$188 million Sewerage and Water Board/ FEMA Funded Water Line Replacement Program.
