****NOTE: This job was previously scheduled for tonight, Sunday, October 25, 2015, but has been rescheduled for Monday night, October 26, 2016 due to inclement weather.**

Residents and businesses in a large section of the city may experience low water pressure beginning at 10 p.m. Monday, October 26, 2015 to 11 a.m. Tuesday, October 27, 2015.

Weather permitting, Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing maintenance on a 50-inch water main.

Traffic Advisory

Motorists are also advised that the center lane of northbound traffic on N. Carrollton Avenue from Canal Street to Iberville Street will be closed to vehicular traffic.
