Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory – Uptown, Downtown, French Quarter, Warehouse District

Residents and businesses in a large section of the city may experience low water pressure beginning at 11 a.m. Monday, November 2, 2015 to 11 a.m. Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing maintenance on a 50-inch water main.

The work is needed to prepare the water main for relocation and tie-in as a part of the SELA Drainage Project.

Efforts will be directed towards minimizing impact to the city, but it will be helpful for customers experiencing problems during this activity to report them by calling 52WATER (529-2837).
