Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory – Uptown, Downtown, French Quarter, Warehouse District

Residents and businesses in a large section of the city may experience low water pressure beginning at 10 p.m. Sunday, October 25, 2015 to 11 a.m. Monday, October 26, 2015.

Weather permitting, Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing maintenance on a 50-inch water main.
