## **LOW WATER PRESSURE AND TRAFFIC ADVISORY**

Residents and businesses on several streets in the Upper Ninth Ward will experience low water pressure beginning at midnight on Monday, October 29 to 7 a.m. on Tuesday, October 30 while crews working for the Sewerage and Water Board repair a water main that serves the area.
