Low Water Pressure – Carondelet Street (Gravier-Canal Street)

Residents and businesses on Carondelet Street between Gravier Street and Canal Street will experience low water pressure overnight on Tuesday, April 28, 2015 at 10:00 p.m. through 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 29, 2015 and again on Wednesday, April 29, 2015 at 10 p.m. through Thursday, April 30, 2015 6 a.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will tie in new water lines that serve the area.

This work is part of the \$183 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Waterline Replacement Program.
