LOW WATER PRESSURE

Residents and businesses on the south side of the 8500 through 8700 blocks of S. Claiborne Avenue between S. Carrollton Avenue and Leonidas Street will experience low water pressure on Monday, July 30, 2012 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. while Cajun Construction, Inc. working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board performs a tie in of a 6-inch water main that serves the city.

On Tuesday, July 31, 2012 the residents on Leonidas Street from S. Claiborne Avenue to Neron Street (one block) will experience low water pressure from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This is also related to the above referenced tie-in.
