Low Water Pressure

Residents and businesses on Leonidas Street from S. Claiborne Avenue to Cohn Street will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, August 1, 2012 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. while Cajun Construction, Inc. working for the Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board performs a tie in of a 6-inch water main that serves the area.

On Thursday, August 2, 2012 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. the south side of the 8500 through 8700 blocks of S. Claiborne Avenue between S. Carrollton Avenue and Leonidas Street will experience low water pressure. This is also related to the above referenced tie-in.
