Low Water Pressure – Burgundy Street (Forstall to Andry)

Residents and businesses on Burgundy Street between Forstall Street and Andry Street will experience low water pressure on Thursday and Friday, April 23rd and 24th, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Weather permitting; Roubion Construction Company will complete a tie-in of a new water line that will serve the area.

The blocks affected are the 5000 through 5300 blocks of Burgundy Street between Forstall Street and Andry Street.

This work is part of the \$183 million Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
