Low Water Pressure Extended for the 4900 block of Burgundy Street

Residents and businesses on the 4900 block of Burgundy Street at Eganina Street in the Holy Cross section of the Lower Ninth Ward will have water pressure restored around 6:30 p.m. this evening. Pressure was originally scheduled to return to normal by 4:30 p.m. but more time is needed for the contractor, Fleming Construction Company, to fully complete the waterline tie-in.

This work is part of the \$183 million dollar Sewerage & Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
