Residents and businesses are advised that a large section of the Holy Cross area will experience low water pressure beginning Tuesday, April 14, 2015 through Friday, April 17, 2015, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day.

Roubion Construction Company will complete the tie-in of a new 24" waterline that has been installed to serve the area.
