## **Low Water Pressure**

Residents and businesses in two different sections of New Orleans will experience low water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, May 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> while Sewerage and Water Board crews repair a series of water line valves.

### **Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

4400-5100 block of Franklin Avenue (eastside) from Dreux Avenue to Gentilly Boulevard will experience low water pressure while repairs are made to valves on a 16" water line that serves the area.

### **Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

7000-8000 blocks of Chef Menteur Highway from Chantilly Drive to Dodt Street will experience low water pressure while repairs are made to water valves on a 6" line that serves the area.
