Low Water Pressure

Residents and businesses in two different sections of New Orleans will experience low water pressure on Saturday and Sunday, May 4th and 5th while Sewerage and Water Board crews repair a series of water line valves.

Saturday, May 4th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

4400-5100 block of Franklin Avenue (eastside) from Dreaux Avenue to Gentilly Boulevard will experience low water pressure while repairs are made to valves on a 16" water line that serves the area.

Sunday, May 5th from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

7000-8000 blocks of Chef Menteur Highway from Chantilly Drive to Dodt Street will experience low water pressure while repairs are made to water valves on a 6" line that serves the area.
