Low Water Pressure Orleans Avenue (Dauphine to Burgundy)

Residents and businesses on Orleans Avenue between Dauphine Street and Burgundy Street will experience low water pressure on Tuesday and Thursday of next week.

Low pressure will occur on Tuesday, June 9, 2015 and again on Thursday, June 11, 2015 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. both days.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will tie in service laterals and also tie in the new water main that will serve the area.

This work is part of the \$184 million Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
