**Sewerage and Water Board crews are performing a water line repair in Algiers this week that will also affect traffic flow.**

Residents and businesses on several streets in the Algiers Area may experience low water pressure overnight on **Thursday, October 19, 2017 beginning at 11 p.m. until Friday morning, October 20, 2017 at 4:00 a.m.** The right westbound lane of General DeGaulle Boulevard will be closed to traffic while work is in progress.

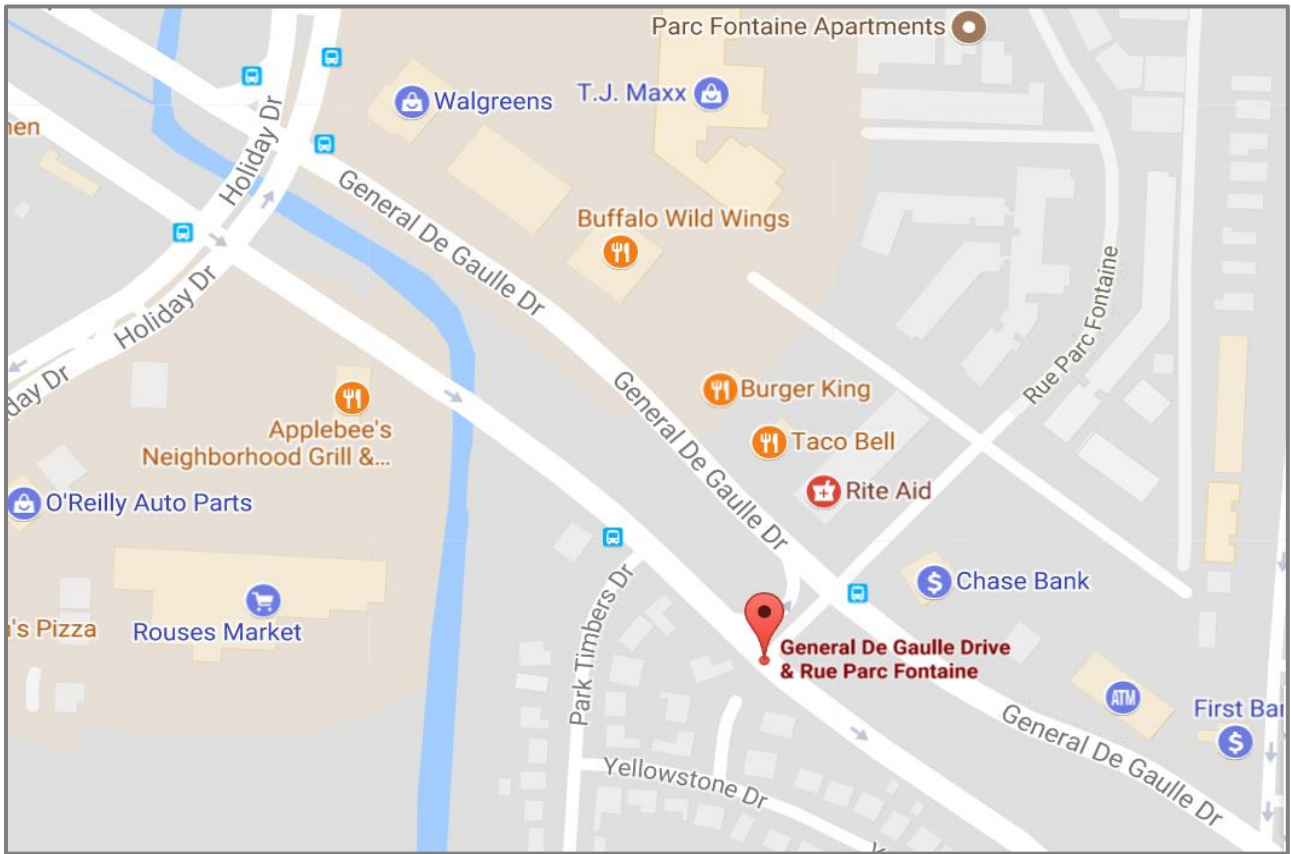
