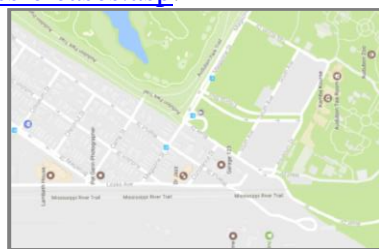
Residents and businesses in the Audubon Park area may experience low water pressure on Wednesday, January 18, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
