Residents and businesses on Carondelet Street from Gravier Street to Canal Street and on Common Street from St. Charles Avenue to Carondelet Street will experience low water pressure overnight on Wednesday, July 1, 2015 at 10 p.m. until Thursday morning, July, 2, 2015 at 6 a.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company will be performing a tie-in on a new water main that serves the area.
