Residents and businesses on Carondelet Street between Louisiana Avenue and 6th Street and on Baronne Street between Louisiana Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Street will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Corps of Engineers and Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a water line that services the area. This work is part of the \$82.6 million Louisiana Avenue Canal, SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
