Residents and businesses in a partial section of the French Quarter area will experience low water pressure on Thursday night, October 29, 2015 at 11:30 p.m. until 7:30 a.m. on Friday morning, October 30, 2015.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a water main that services the area.

This work is part of the \$188 million Sewerage and Water Board/FEMA Funded Waterline Replacement Program.
