Residents and businesses on Dumaine Street between Decatur Street and Chartres Street will experience low water pressure on Thursday night, June 9, 2016 from 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. on Friday morning, June 10, 2016. This work is part of the \$188 million FEMA funded waterline replacement project.
