Sewerage and Water Board crews are currently **performing a repair to a broken water main on the 2400 block of Tulane Avenue.** The water main was broken by a private contractor earlier today, Thursday, September 15, 2016.

Residents and businesses in the area are not expected to experience low water pressure at this time.
