Sewerage and Water Board will be performing water line work. B&K Construction Company, working for Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Corps of Engineers, will be replacing a water line that services the area.

Residents and businesses in the Freret Street Area experience low water pressure on Tuesday, December 20, 2016 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. This work is part of the \$55.9 million Jefferson Avenue Canal Phase I- SELA Drainage Project.
