This work is part of the \$147.5 million Florida Avenue Canal Phase IV- SELA Drainage Project.

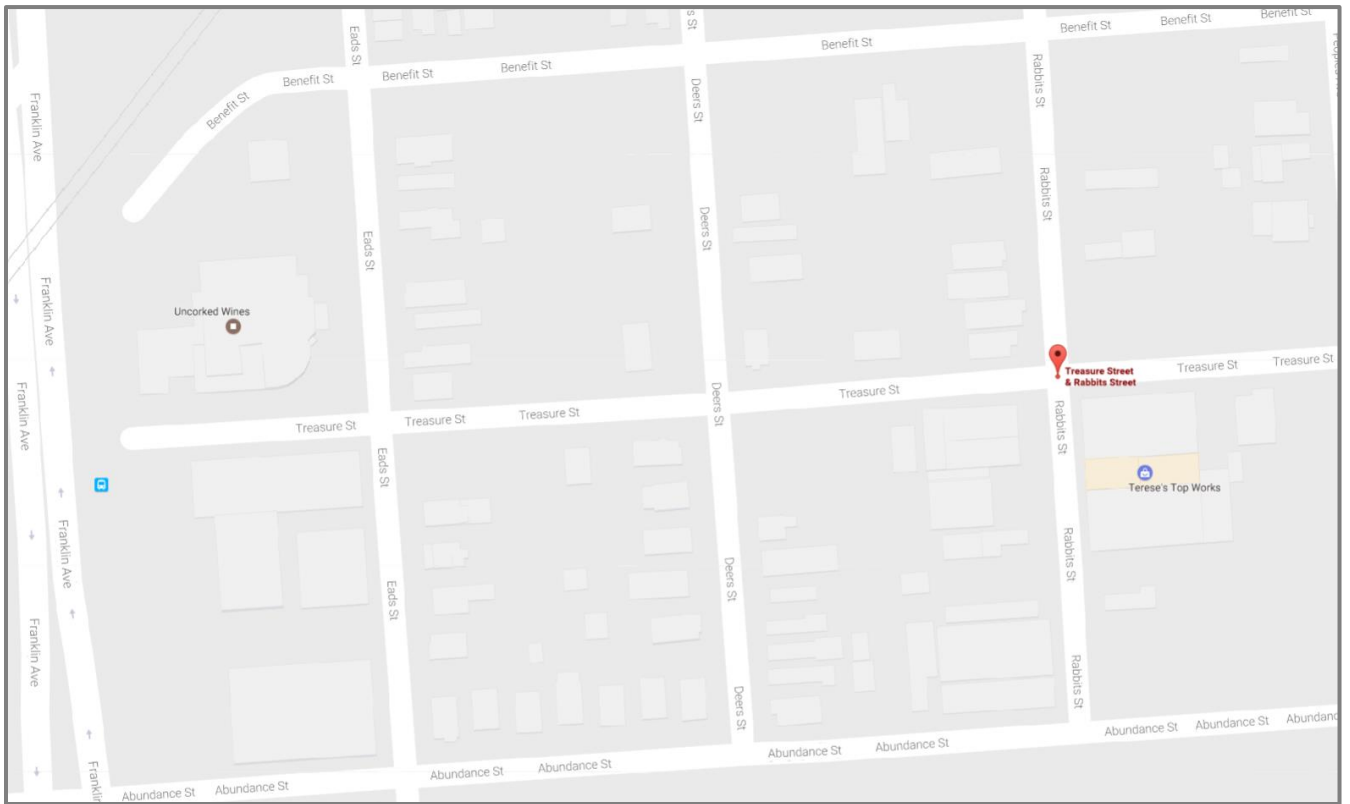
