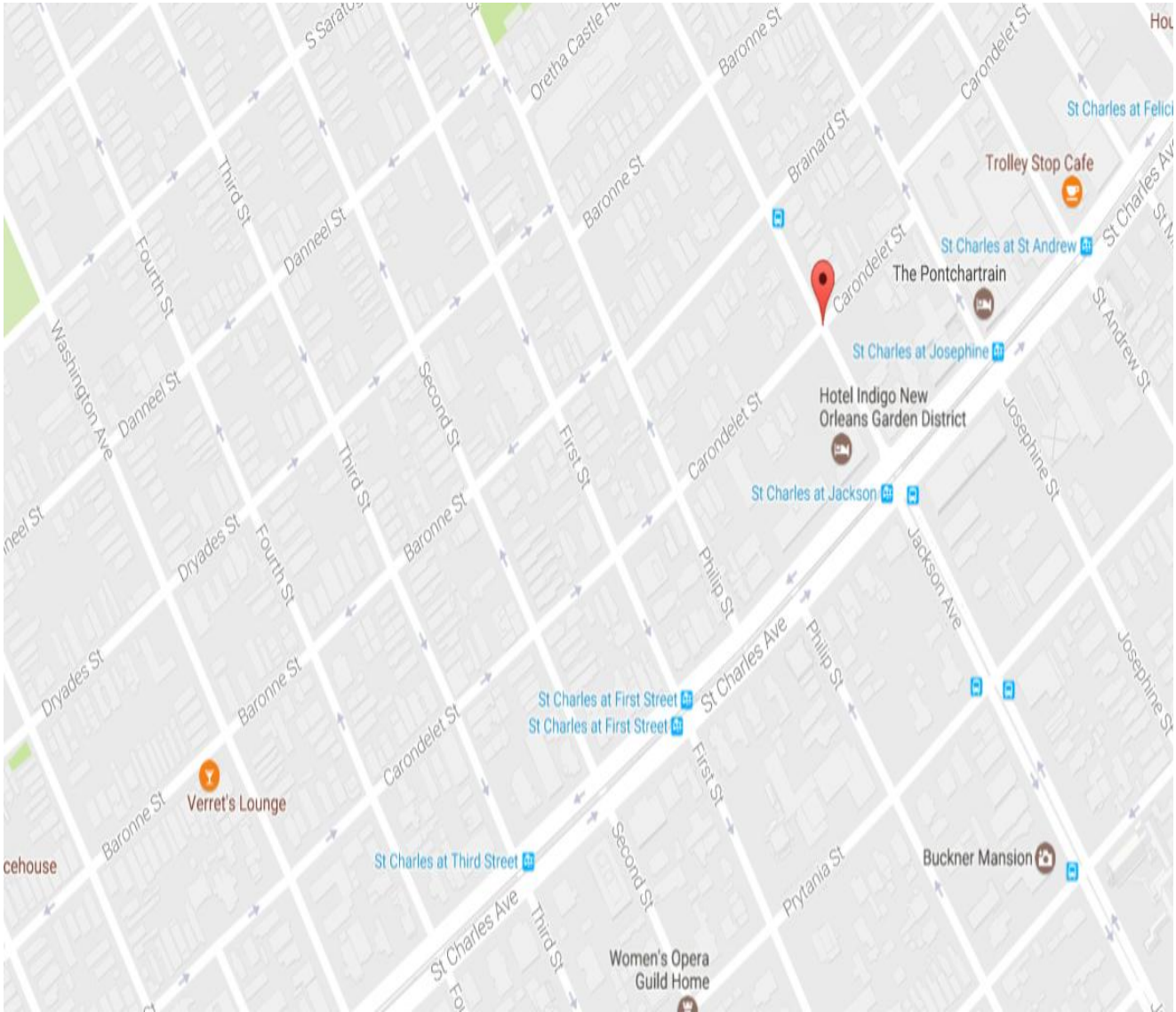
Lakebound – St. Charles Avenue to Washington to Jackson Avenue
