We're Improving Your Water System- Louisiana Avenue

Residents and businesses on the Northbound and Southbound sides of Louisiana Avenue between Baronne Street and St. Charles Avenue will experience low water pressure on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a 4" water line that serves the area. This work is part of the \$82.6 million Louisiana Avenue Canal- SELA Project.
