## We're Improving Your Water System- Loyola Avenue

Boh Bros Construction Company, working for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineer and the Sewerage and Water Board, will be cutting and capping a line to replace a 20" water line that serves the area.

Residents and businesses on Loyola Avenue will experience low water pressure on Monday, April 25, 2016 from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. This work is part of the \$82.6 million Louisiana Avenue Canal- SELA Project.
