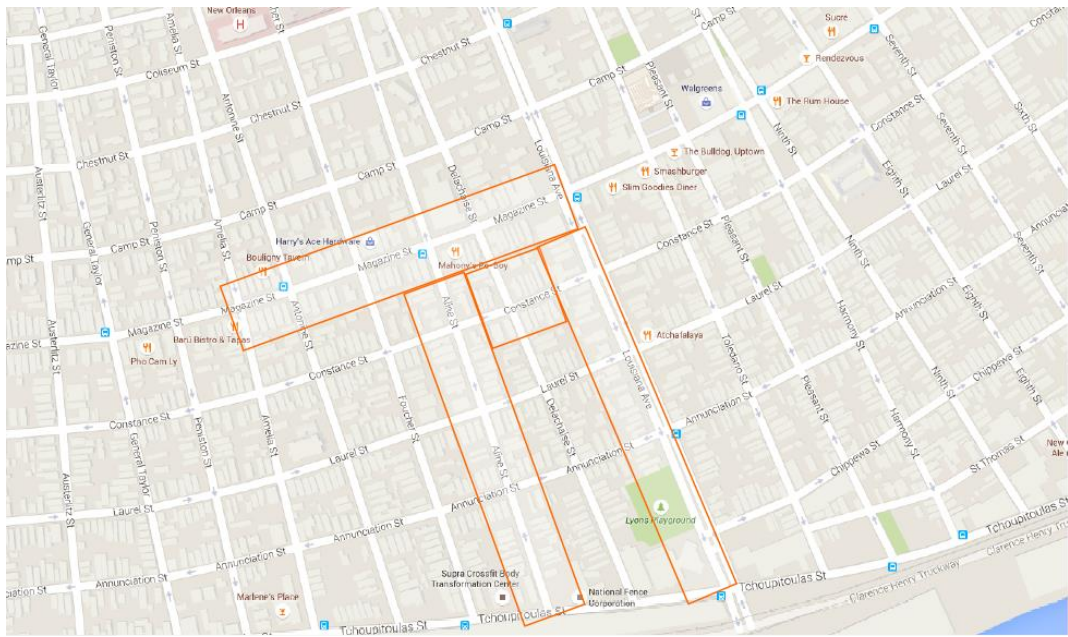
Low Water Pressure in the Magazine Street Area
