Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a water line that serves the area.

Residents and businesses on Picayune Place between Gravier Street and Natchez Street will experience low water pressure on Tuesday morning, July 5, 2016 and Wednesday morning, July 6, 2016 from 1 a.m. until 5 a.m. on both days. This work is part of the \$188 million FEMA funded waterline replacement project.
