We're Improving Your Water System- St. Charles and Jefferson Avenues

Residents and businesses on St. Charles Avenue (Northside) between Jefferson Avenue and Soniat Street and on Jefferson Avenue (Eastside) between Dryades Street and St. Charles Avenue will experience low water pressure on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

Cajun Construction Company, working for the US Army Corps of Engineers and the Sewerage and Water Board, will be performing a tie-in of a water line that services the area. This work is part of the \$46.2 million Jefferson Avenue Canal, SELA Urban Flood Improvement Program.
