We’re Improving Your Water System- Uptown/ Central City Area

Boh Brothers Construction Company, working for the Sewerage and Water Board and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will be performing a tie-in of a new 20” water main that will serve the area.

Residents and businesses in the Uptown/ Central City area will experience low water pressure on Thursday, July 21, 2016 at 10 p.m. until Friday, July 22, 2016 at 6 a.m. This work is part of the \$82.6 million SELA Louisiana Avenue Canal Project.
