Low Water Pressure/Traffic Advisory-Warehouse District

Magazine St. from Girod to Andrew Higgins and
Magazine Street from Girod Street to Julia Street

Residents and businesses in a small area of the Warehouse District will experience low water pressure on Sunday and Monday, June 29th and 30th from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. both days while Boh Bros. Construction Company ties in a 30-inch water main that serves the area.

This work was originally scheduled for the 25th and 26th but had to be postponed because of inclement weather conditions.

The blocks affected are Magazine Street from Girod Street to Andrew Higgins.
