S&WB Elects Manning President Pro Tem

WM. Raymond Manning has been elected President Pro Tem of the Sewerage & Water Board of New Orleans by its Board of Directors.

The action took place during the Board’s monthly meeting on Nov. 16. Manning, who became a member of the S&WB in February, is president and CEO of Manning Architects. Over the past 25 years his creative leadership has established his firm with a regional and national reputation in architecture, interior design, urban design and planning.

He is currently working on the City’s master and comprehensive zoning plans. In May, at the national meeting of the American Institute of Architects held in New Orleans, Manning was elevated to its College of Fellows.

For this prestigious honor he received praise and recognition via a resolution from the Louisiana Legislature. He is President-Elect of the New Orleans Chapter of the American Institute of Architects.

He represents the Board of Liquidation, City Debt on the S&WB. As president pro tem he will conduct meetings in the absence of the Mayor, who is president of the Board. He will also serve on all Board committees and chair the Executive Committee.

He replaces Tommie A. Vassel whose term on the Board ended in October.
