Sewerage and Water Board Pumping Stations Staffed and Fully Operational In Advance of Severe Weather Forecasted

The Sewerage and Water Board is reporting that in advance of severe weather forecasted by the National Weather Service for Monday afternoon and evening, as well as Tuesday, all 24 pumping stations are staffed and fully operational.

We would remind residents to remove all trash, leaves and/or debris that would block their drainage catch basins. In addition, we would remind residents that our drainage system is capable of removing one inch of rain in the first hour of an event and one half inch per hour thereafter.

Again, the S&WB is prepared for the advancing severe weather. The preparation is part of the board's year-round continuous drainage operations and planning. All pumps are fully operational and staffed.
