Traffic Advisory – Freret Street at Jefferson Avenue Closed for Two Weeks

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that beginning on Monday, January 11, 2016 until Monday, January 25, 2016, Freret Street will be closed to vehicular traffic at Jefferson Avenue for installation of a sewer line.

Traffic traveling eastbound (downtown) on Freret Street will not be able to access Jefferson Avenue and will be detoured at Nashville Avenue and Octavia Street.

Traffic traveling westbound (Uptown) on Freret Street will be able to turn north or south onto Jefferson Avenue but will not be able to cross Jefferson Avenue. This closure will not affect north and south traffic on Jefferson Avenue.

This work is part of the \$55.9 million SELA-Jefferson Avenue-Phase I Project.
