We're Improving Your Water System/ Traffic Advisory - Central City Area

Sewerage and Water Board crews will be performing water line work that will affect traffic flow on several streets in the Central City area.

Residents, businesses and motorists are advised that traffic on Martin Luther King Boulevard from S. Derbigny Street to S. Claiborne Avenue and Josephine Street between S. Derbigny Street and S. Claiborne Avenue will be reduced to one lane on Wednesday, November 9, 2016 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

S. Claiborne Avenue between First Street and Phillip Street will be reduced to two lanes from 11 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
