**Traffic Advisory – Freret Street** 

Motorists, residents and businesses are advised that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, partnering with the Sewerage and Water Board, will be temporarily closing Freret Street to vehicular traffic beginning Monday, November 9, 2015.

Weather permitting, Freret Street will be closed on the west side of Jefferson Avenue for approximately one week. Traffic traveling east bound (downtown) on Freret Street will not be able to access Jefferson Avenue and will be detoured at Nashville Avenue and Octavia Street.

Traffic traveling west bound (Uptown) on Freret Street will be able to turn north or south on Jefferson Avenue, but motorists will not be able to cross Jefferson Avenue. The closure will not affect the north and south bound traffic on Jefferson Avenue.

A pedestrian crossing will be in place at S. Robertson Street.

This street closure is for the installation of a water line that services the area. The work is part of the Southeast Louisiana Urban Flood Control Project (SELA).

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
