Traffic Advisory – Louisiana Avenue at Magnolia Street

Motorists, residents and businesses are advised that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, partnering with the Sewerage and Water Board, will temporarily shift vehicular traffic on Louisiana Avenue at Magnolia Street beginning Monday, November 23, 2015, weather permitting.

A phased traffic signal will be in place at the intersection of Louisiana Avenue and Magnolia Street allowing south bound (river bound) and north bound (lake bound) traffic to cross the intersection intermittently. During this time, east bound (downtown bound) traffic on Magnolia Street will not be able to access Louisiana Avenue.

This traffic shift is for the installation of a new sewer main that services the area and will last approximately nine days. The work is part of the Southeast Louisiana Urban Flood Control Project (SELA).

We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the City's infrastructure.
