Traffic Advisory – Gravier Street and Poydras Street

Residents, businesses and motorists on Gravier Street between LaSalle Street and S. Claiborne Avenue are advised that Gravier Street will be reduced to one lane of traffic beginning on Wednesday, October 15, 2014 through Friday, October 17, 2014 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., while Boh Brothers performs the milling, overlay and striping work to conclude the final street restoration in the area.

Also affected by final restoration work are the left turning lanes of O'Keefe Street and the left lane on Poydras Street between O'Keefe and South Rampart Street. Both will be reduced to one lane of traffic while work is in progress.

This work is part of the FEMA funded Waterline Replacement Program.
